What are the advantages of a Visegrad scholarship?


Visegrad scholarships are available for undergraduate, postgraduate, PhD and postdoctoral students in all different disciplines. You can study in any language and study for up to four semesters. There is also no age limit, so you can apply even if you are already out of school. You can also apply for a travel grant.

Where can you study with our scholarship?

You can study at any accredited public or private higher-education institution (college, university, science academy, art academy) in the V4 region and/or in the countries of the Eastern Partnership or Western Balkans.

Are you eligible for a scholarship?

You have to be a citizen of one of the V4 countries and to have successfully completed at least four semesters of university studies at the time of applying for the scholarship.
